6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to composition of election boards."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 15.10.120 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 15.10.120. APPOINTMENT OF ELECTION BOARD. (a) The election
10 supervisors shall appoint within their district an election board,
11 composed of three judges, for each precinct from among the qualified
12 voters of each of the precincts for which they are appointed. One
13 judge shall be designated chairman and be primarily responsible for
14 the administration of the election in the precinct. If no clerks are
15 appointed for the precinct, the other two judges shall perform the
16 duties of clerks of the election. No more than two judges may be of
17 the same political party. When appointments to the election board have
18 been accepted, the election supervisor shall notify the secretary of
19 state of the name and full local mailing address of the designated
20 chairman and other judges of the election board in each precinct.
21 Election boards in local government unit elections shall be appointed
22 by the appropriate local government unit for all local elections.
23 No election judge appointed under this section or AS 15.10.125 shall
24 be a member of the immediate family of a candidate whose name appears
25 on the ballot in the election precinct or local election for which he
26 is appointed to serve.

27 (b) As used in this section "immediate family" means one's
28 child, father, mother, brother, sister or spouse.
