6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Pioneers' Home."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 47.25.020(b) is amended to read:

9 (b) Every person admitted to the Pioneers' Home, except a person  
10 admitted under sec. 30 of this chapter, who receives income from any  
11 source in excess of \$20 a month may be required by the Office of the  
12 Governor to pay the excess to the Office of the Governor immediately  
13 upon receipt of the money in payment, or part payment, of the cost  
14 of his maintenance. No charge may be made in excess of the cost of  
15 care and maintenance, either by money or by the sale of real or  
16 personal property.

18 Sec. 47.25.030. ADMISSION ON PAYMENT. A citizen of the United  
19 States over 65 years of age who is a resident of the state and has been  
20 a resident for not less than 15 years continuously immediately preceding  
21 his application, but who is not destitute, may on application be  
22 admitted to the home upon his agreement to pay to the state a sum for  
23 each day as the Office of the Governor considers sufficient to compen-  
24 sate the state for the cost of care and support of the person at the  
25 home. No charge may be made in excess of the cost of care and  
26 maintenance, either by money or by the sale of real or personal property
