6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing a fish egg tax."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 43.75.010(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to  
9 read:

10 (5) canneries or processing plants which process any variety  
11 of fish eggs shall pay a license tax equal to six per cent of the value  
12 of the fish eggs purchased or obtained during the year, except that if  
13 over 80 per cent of the employees of the canneries are residents of the  
14 state, the annual tax paid shall be equal to three per cent of the  
15 value of the fish eggs purchased or obtained during the year.

17 Sec. 43.75.130. REFUND TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS. The commissioner of  
18 revenue shall pay to each organized borough, city of the first, second,  
19 and third classes, incorporated or independent school district, and  
20 public utility district 10 per cent of the amount of tax revenue  
21 collected in the municipality or district from taxes levied by secs. 10  
22 90 of this chapter, except that 20 per cent of the amount of revenue  
23 collected under sec. 10(a)(5) of this chapter shall be paid to each  
24 organized borough, and 20 per cent of the amount of revenue collected  
25 under sec. 10(a)(5) of this chapter shall be paid to each city of the  
26 first, second and third classes.  
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
