6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to gold, jade and ivory."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 11.20.510 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 Sec. 11.20.510. LABELING OF IMITATION ALASKA GOLD, JADE OR IVORY.

10 (a) It is unlawful for a person to sell or offer to sell imitation  
11 Alaska gold, jade or ivory or jewelry containing imitation Alaska  
12 gold, jade or ivory without having a label affixed, setting forth in  
13 legible type or writing, the material used in the jade or ivory and  
14 the percentage of gold in jewelry containing or advertised as containing  
15 gold. The term "gold nugget" may only be used to describe genuine,  
16 natural, unaltered gold in lump form. All manufactured gold which  
17 imitates nugget gold must be clearly labeled or stamped imitation nugget  
18 jewelry and state the percentage of gold contained in the imitation  
19 nugget.

20 (b) A person violating this section is guilty of a misdemeanor  
21 and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.
