6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to political contributions."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 43.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 43.20.035. POLITICAL CONTRIBUTIONS. (a) An individual tax-
10 payer may specify, on his income tax return, an amount of either \$5,
11 \$10, or \$25 to be contributed to each political party or parties desig-
12 nated by the taxpayer. The amount the taxpayer specifies shall be
13 paid from the amount of tax due under this chapter.

14 (b) For purposes of this section a political party is a national
15 political party with an Alaskan affiliate.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 44.21.020 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

17 (11) administer the political contributions account.

18 * Sec. 3. AS 44.21 is amended by adding new sections to read:

19 ARTICLE 3. POLITICAL CONTRIBUTIONS ACCOUNT.

20 Sec. 44.21.140. POLITICAL CONTRIBUTIONS ACCOUNT. There is in the
21 Department of Administration a political contributions account which the
22 department shall administer.

23 Sec. 44.21.150. REVENUES. Money designated by a taxpayer under
24 AS 43.20.035 shall be deposited in the general fund and a special
25 account kept of the money deposited.

26 Sec. 44.21.160. APPROPRIATIONS. The legislature may appropriate
27 an amount equal to the balance in the political contributions account
28 to the central committee of the political parties of the state as
29 designated by the individual taxpayers under AS 43.20.035.
