6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the marketing of salmon."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 16.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 16.10.290. PRICE DISPUTES BETWEEN FISHERMEN AND FISH
10 PROCESSORS. (a) In an area where a price dispute exists between
11 commercial fishermen and fish processors on the price to be paid for
12 salmon, and no agreement has been reached up to 30 days before the
13 opening of the salmon fishing season in that area, a representative
14 from the Department of Labor shall intervene as mediator of the dis-
15 pute.

16 (b) If the mediation proceedings provided for in (a) of this
17 section fails, then the state shall invite other processors to process
18 the salmon at a price which is agreeable to the interested parties.
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
