5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring approval by voters of each first
7 class or home rule city on the question of borough-
8 city unification."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 29.85.100(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) The votes on unification shall be tabulated by [IN TWO]
12 separate classifications. Separate classifications [ONE CLASSIFICATION]
13 shall consist of [ALL] votes cast in each [THE] first class and home
14 rule city [CITIES] of the borough. An additional [THE OTHER] classifi-
15 cation shall consist of all votes cast in the remaining areas of the
16 borough. In order for unification to be approved it is necessary that
17 a majority of the votes in each classification favor unification.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 29.85.160(c) is amended to read:

19 (c) If a majority of the votes cast in the area of the borough
20 outside all first class and home rule cities and a majority of the
21 votes cast in each first class and home rule city [THE REMAINING AREA
22 OF THE BOROUGH, COMPOSED OF ALL FIRST CLASS AND HOME RULE CITIES,] are
23 cast in favor of the proposed charter, the charter is ratified. If the
24 charter is ratified, two copies of the charter shall be filed with each
25 of the following authorities:

- 26 (1) secretary of state,
27 (2) director of the Local Affairs Agency,
28 (3) district recorder for the area of the borough,
29 (4) clerk of the borough,

(5) clerk of each city in the borough.
