6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to sale of timber and materials."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 38.05.115 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 38.05.115. LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE. (a) The  
10 commissioner, upon recommendation of the director, shall determine the  
11 timber and other materials to be sold, and the limitations, conditions  
12 and terms of sale. The limitations, conditions and terms shall  
13 include the utilization, development and maintenance of the sustained  
14 yield principle, subject to preference among other beneficial uses.  
15 The director may negotiate sales of timber or materials without  
16 advertisement and on the limitations, conditions, and terms which he  
17 considers are in the best interests of the state, subject to the  
18 approval of the commissioner. However, not more than 500 M.B.M. of  
19 timber or more than \$2,500 of materials may be sold by non-advertised,  
20 negotiated sale to the same purchaser within a one-year period.

21 (b) Negotiated sales for timber or materials not exceeding a  
22 value of \$250 are exempt from the provisions of AS 34.15.150 [THE  
23 DIRECTOR MAY NEGOTIATE TIMBER SALES NOT EXCEEDING 500 M.B.M., OR  
24 MATERIAL SALES NOT EXCEEDING THE APPRAISED VALUE OF \$2,500 WITHOUT  
25 ADVERTISEMENT AND ON THE LIMITATIONS, CONDITIONS AND TERMS WHICH HE  
26 CONSIDERS ARE IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE STATE, SUBJECT TO THE  
27 APPROVAL OF THE COMMISSIONER. NOT MORE THAN ONE NON-ADVERTISED,  
28 NEGOTIATED SALE OF TIMBER OR MATERIAL MAY BE MADE TO THE SAME PUR-  
29 CHASER WITHIN A ONE-YEAR PERIOD].
