6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for loans to certain rural communi-
7 ties for the purpose of establishing boarding home
8 dormitory facilities for school children."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 14 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

11 CHAPTER 32. RURAL COMMUNITY BOARDING HOME ACT.

12 Sec. 14.32.010. PURPOSE. The purpose of this chapter is to aid
13 rural communities with schools in establishing dormitory facilities in
14 order that children from nearby villages without schools may attend
15 school and be cared for by boarding home parents.

16 Sec. 14.32.020. POWERS OF THE DEPARTMENT. The department may

17 (1) make loans to incorporated native associations and to
18 communities incorporated under federal law and cities of all classes in-
19 corporated under state law, except home rule cities, for the purpose of
20 constructing, leasing, or purchasing boarding home dormitory facilities
21 for school children;

22 (2) designate agents and delegate its powers to them as
23 necessary;

24 (3) enter into agreements with private institutions, other
25 state agencies, or agencies of the federal government to carry out the
26 purpose of this chapter;

27 (4) adopt regulations necessary to carry out the provisions
28 of this chapter.

29 Sec. 14.32.030. LIMITATIONS ON LOANS. A loan made under this

1 chapter may not run longer than 20 years nor bear interest exceeding
2 six per cent. Each loan shall be secured, in the case of a loan to a
3 city or community, by the pledge of its full faith and credit, and in
4 the case of a native association, by collateral as determined by the
5 commissioner.

6 Sec. 14.32.040. CREATION OF FUND. There is a rural community
7 boarding home revolving fund to carry out the purpose of this chapter.
8 The fund shall be administered by the department.
