6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the persons eligible to receive
7 workmen's compensation benefits."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23.30.265(7) is amended to read:

10 (7) "child," "grandchild," "brother," and "sister," include
11 only persons who are under 19 years of age, [AND] persons who, though
12 19 years of age or over, are wholly dependent upon the deceased
13 employee and incapable of self-support by reason of mental or physical
14 disability, and persons of any age while they are attending the first
15 four years vocational school, trade school, or college, and persons of
16 any age while they are attending high school;
