6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the practice of psychology."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 08.86.020 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 Sec. 08.86.020. APPOINTMENT AND TERM OF OFFICE. The governor
10 shall appoint the members of the board for staggered terms of three
11 years from a list of qualified psychologists submitted by the Alaska
12 Psychological Association. The appointed members are subject to
13 confirmation by the legislature but shall serve at the pleasure of
14 the governor.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 08.86.050 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

16 Sec. 08.86.050. TRANSPORTATION AND PER DIEM. Board members are
17 entitled to transportation and per diem expenses authorized by law.

18 * Sec. 3. AS 08.86.070 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

19 (4) elect from its membership a president and secretary.

20 * Sec. 4. AS 08.86 is amended by adding a new section to read:

21 Sec. 08.86.125. CONTENTS OF EXAMINATION. The board shall
22 examine in subjects it considers necessary to test the applicant's
23 ability and fitness to practice professional psychology. The board
24 may use the examination of professional practice in psychology of
25 the professional examination service of the American Public Health
26 Association.

27 * Sec. 5. AS 08.86.140 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

28 Sec. 08.86.140. FEES. The following fees shall be charged under
29 this chapter when applicable:

- (1) application \$25
- (2) examination 25
- (3) license 25
- (4) biennial license renewal . 25
- (5) license by reciprocity . . 5).

■ Sec. 6. AS 08.86.150 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 08.86.150. LICENSE BY RECIPROCITY. A person who is licensed or certified by examination as a psychologist by an authority other than Alaska is entitled to be licensed in Alaska without examination if he completes and returns the proper application forms and pays the reciprocity fee and if

(1) he holds a doctoral degree with primary emphasis on psychology from an accredited school so recognized by the board;

(2) the requirements for registration by the licensing or certifying authority, at the date of his registration, were substantially equal to the requirements of this state, and if the licensing or certifying authority gives a similar privilege of registration without examination to a person registered in this state; or

(3) he is a diplomate in good standing of the American Board of Examiners in Professional Psychology.
