6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Public School Foundation  
7 Program; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.17.030(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The required local effort of each district is [THE SUM OF]  
11 the required local tax effort [OF THE DISTRICT AND ONE-HALF OF PUBLIC  
12 LAW 874 MONEY RECEIVED FROM THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT IN THE PRE-FISCAL  
13 YEAR].

14 \* Sec. 2. AS 14.17.075 is amended to read:

15 Sec. 14.17.075. SUPPLEMENTAL ALLOCATION. (a) In addition to  
16 the amounts authorized to be paid to school districts under this  
17 chapter, a supplemental allocation equivalent to \$15 per pupil in  
18 total average daily membership for the purpose of further equalization  
19 of disparities due to size and availability of local resources may be  
20 made. These allocations shall be distributed on the basis of average  
21 daily membership in the inverse ratio that each district's [TOTAL  
22 EQUIVALENT] evaluation per pupil bears to the average [EQUIVALENT]  
23 evaluation per pupil. However, for a district whose [TOTAL EQUIVALENT]  
24 evaluation per pupil is below the average, and whose average daily  
25 membership is below 600, the allocation may be increased by 10 per  
26 cent for each unit of 100 by which the district average daily member-  
27 ship, rounded to the nearest 100, is less than 600, provided that the  
28 district makes a local contribution of not less than that which would  
29 be raised by a 10-mill levy.

1 (b) For purposes of computing allocations under this section,  
2 district [TOTAL EQUIVALENT] evaluation per pupil is [THE SUM OF THE  
3 AMOUNT THAT 50 PER CENT OF THE P.L. 874 ENTITLEMENT WOULD REPRESENT  
4 AS THE BASE OF A 10-MILL LEVY AND] the evaluation of the district,  
5 divided by the average daily membership. The reports of the public  
6 school foundation program shall be used in applying this formula.

9 (c) The commissioner shall make adjustments necessary to insure  
10 that no district receives less than \$15 per pupil in ADM under this  
11 section [WHEN INCREASED PAYMENTS TO THE DISTRICT FROM STATE TUITION  
12 OVER THE PRIOR YEAR ARE CONSIDERED].

13 \* Sec. 3. AS 14.17.130(b) and 14.17.250(7) are repealed.

14 \* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and  
15 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
