6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the licensing of boiler operators;  
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 18.60 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 18.60.390. (a) The Department of Labor shall promulgate  
11 regulations for the licensing of boiler operators. The regulations  
12 shall conform to the generally accepted nationwide standards and prac-  
13 tices established for boiler operators.

14 (b) Operators licenses shall be provided in the following cate-  
15 gories:

16 (1) fireman - apprentice

17 (2) third class - boiler capacity not to exceed 3,500 lbs. an  
18 hour

19 (3) second class - boiler capacity not to exceed 100,000 lbs.  
20 an hour

21 (4) first class - unlimited

22 (c) A person, firm or corporation who violates a regulation  
23 promulgated under (a) of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and  
24 upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000.

25 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 1970.
