6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing state aid to local school districts
7 which bear the impact of educating children whose
8 parent works on or lives on state property; and pro-
9 viding for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 14.17 is amended by adding a new section to read:

12 Sec. 14.17.215. STATE AID TO DISTRICTS AFFECTED BY STATE
13 ACTIVITIES. A school district which provides free public education to
14 a student whose parent works on or lives on state property shall receive
15 an additional yearly allotment under this chapter equal to the per-
16 centage of the state average cost of education, as reflected in the
17 audit report of district schools for the prior fiscal year, per
18 student times the number of qualifying students in average daily mem-
19 bership, as follows:

20 (1) 50% for a student whose parent lives on and works on
21 state property;

22 (2) 25% for a student whose parent works on state property.

23 (b) In this section "state property" means the real
24 property which is owned by the state or is leased by the state and
25 which is not subject to taxation or payments in lieu of taxes by the
26 state or a political subdivision of the state; the term includes real
27 property owned by the state and leased from it, as well as improvements
28 leased from it, even though the lessee's interest, or an improvement
29 on the property, is subject to taxation by a state or a political

subdivision of the state.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1969.
