6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing state aid to cities and organized
7 boroughs for police protection services; and pro-
8 viding for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 18.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 ARTICLE 2. STATE AID FOR LOCAL POLICE PROTECTION.

12 Sec. 18.65.150. STATE AID TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS. During each
13 fiscal year the state shall pay to a city or organized borough of any
14 class which has power to provide for police protection and exercises the
15 power a sum to be used for protection services equal to \$5 per capita
16 for the population of the city or borough, as determined by the latest
17 figures of the United States Bureau of the Census or other reliable
18 population data. If a borough exercises the power in the borough area
19 outside cities only, or within a service area only, the grant author-
20 ized under this section shall be based on the population of the
21 borough area outside cities or the service area respectively.

22 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1969.
