6 For an Act entitled "An Act amending the Pharmacy Act."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 08.80.030 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

9 (5) promulgate regulations to carry out the purposes of this
10 chapter.

11 * Sec. 2. AS 08.80.110 is amended to read:

12 Sec. 08.80.110. QUALIFICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION. An applicant for
13 registration as a pharmacist shall

14 (1) be at least 21 years of age, a citizen of the United
15 States and fluent in the reading, writing and speaking of the English
16 language;

17 (2) furnish the board with at least two affidavits from
18 reputable citizens attesting to his good moral character and freedom
19 from addiction to the use of drugs or alcoholic liquors;

20 (3) be a graduate of a college of pharmacy recognized by the
21 National Association of Boards of Pharmacy, and have completed, after
22 graduation, an internship of 540 hours at 40 hours a week under the
23 direct supervision of a licensed pharmacist in a licensed pharmacy;

24 (4) pass an examination by a board of pharmacy which board
25 has been approved by the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy;

26 (5) when the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy re-
27 quires a state to have an intern program as a qualification for member-
28 ship in the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy, have completed
29 the intern program.

2 Sec. 08.80.140. LICENSE BY RECIPROCITY. The board may register
3 without examination an applicant [WHO IS OTHERWISE QUALIFIED AND] who
4 has been certified as a registered pharmacist by the National
5 Association of Boards of Pharmacy.
