6 For an Act entitled: "An Act amending the Pharmacy Act."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 08.80.030 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

9 (5) promulgate regulations to carry out the purposes of
10 this chapter.

11 * Sec. 2. AS 08.80.110 is amended to read:

12 Sec. 08.80.110. QUALIFICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION. An applicant
13 for registration as a pharmacist shall

14 (1) be [AT LEAST 21 YEARS OF AGE,] a citizen of the United
15 States and fluent in the reading, writing and speaking of the English
16 language;

17 (2) furnish the board with at least two affidavits from
18 reputable citizens attesting to his good moral character and freedom
19 from addiction to the use of drugs or alcoholic liquors;

20 (3) be a graduate of a college of pharmacy recognized by
21 the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy;

22 (4) pass an examination by a board of pharmacy which board
23 has been approved by the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy;

24 (5) have completed, after graduation, an internship of
25 540 hours at 40 hours a week under the direct supervision of a licensed
26 pharmacist in a licensed pharmacy, provided that if the National Associ-
27 ation of Boards of Pharmacy requires a state to have an intern program
28 as a qualification for membership in the national association, have
29 completed such intern program if the board so requires.

2 Sec. 08.80.140. LICENSE BY RECIPROCITY. The board may register
3 without examination an applicant [WHO IS OTHERWISE QUALIFIED AND] who
4 has been certified as a registered pharmacist by the National Associ-
5 ation of Boards of Pharmacy.
