BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 11.15.010 is amended to read:

Sec. 11.15.010. FIRST DEGREE MURDER. A person who, being of

sound memory and discretion, purposely, and either of deliberate and

11

premeditated malice or by means of poison, or in perpetrating or in

12

attempting to perpetrate, rape, arson, robbery, or burglary kills an-

13

other, is guilty of murder in the first degree, and shall, upon convic-

14

tion, be sentenced to imprisonment for not less than 20 years to life

15

or, in the discretion of the jury, to death.
