SIXTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act providing workmen's compensation coverage for members of state boards and commissions; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 23.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 23.30.242. MEMBERS OF STATE BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS AS EMPLOYEES. (a) A person is considered an employee under this chapter only while he is actually traveling or working as a member of a state board or commission. The maximum weekly wage shall be used in computing the amount of compensation to be awarded.

(b) Annual appropriations to fund the coverage provided for in (a) of this section shall be provided for within the budget of the office of the governor.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1969.
