6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to a comprehensive transportation
7 study for the area north of the Yukon River; and pro-
8 viding for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. For the purpose of developing a long-range transportation
11 plan, the Department of Highways and the Department of Public Works shall
12 conduct a comprehensive transportation study for the area of the state north
13 of the Yukon River. These departments shall review the adequacy and plan
14 the improvement or establishment of harbors, roads and access roads, airports,
15 monorail systems, hovercraft routes, riverboat routes, foot trails, dog team
16 routes, snowmobile routes, and other transportation systems.

17 * Sec. 2. The Departments of Highways and Public Works shall use their
18 own engineers and contract with any additional engineers necessary in prepar-
19 ing the study.

20 * Sec. 3. The information gathered and plans made under this study shall
21 be submitted to the governor 15 months after the beginning of the study, but
22 not later than April 1, 1971.

23 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 1969.
