8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.20.120(4) is amended to read:

10 (4) is a graduate of a legally chartered fully accredited
11 school or college of chiropractic, approved by the board, which requires
12 for graduation a residence course of instruction of not less than four
13 years of nine months each; accreditation must be by one or both of the
14 national chiropractic organizations, either the International Chiro-
15 practors Association or the American Chiropractors Association;
