6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to compensation of judicial officers;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 22.05.140(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The monthly salary of the chief justice is 95 per cent of
11 the monthly salary of the governor. The monthly salary of each
12 associate justice is 91 per cent of the monthly salary of the governor
13 [THE CHIEF JUSTICE SHALL RECEIVE \$27,000 ANNUALLY, AND EACH ASSOCIATE
14 JUSTICE SHALL RECEIVE \$26,000 ANNUALLY AS COMPENSATION. THE COMPEN-
15 SATION IS PAYABLE MONTHLY IN 12 EQUAL INSTALLMENTS]. Compensation of
16 the chief justice or of an associate justice shall not be diminished
17 during his term of office, unless by general law applying to all
18 salaried officers of the state.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 22.10.190(a) is amended to read:

20 (a) The monthly salary of each superior court judge is 83 per
21 cent of the monthly salary of the governor [EACH SUPERIOR COURT JUDGE
22 SHALL RECEIVE \$23,000 ANNUALLY, AS COMPENSATION, PAYABLE MONTHLY IN
23 12 EQUAL INSTALLMENTS]. The compensation of a judge shall not be
24 diminished during his term of office, unless by general law applying
25 to all salaried officers of the state.

26 * Sec. 3. AS 22.15.220(a) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

27 (a) The monthly salary of each district court judge is 61 per
28 cent of the monthly salary of the governor.

29 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day the annual salary of the

1 governor is increased to more than \$30,000.
