6 For an Act entitled: "An Act creating a Parks and Recreation Advisory
7 Commission."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 38 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 40. PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY COMMISSION.

11 Sec. 38.40.010. PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY COMMISSION. There
12 is a Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission in the Department of
13 Natural Resources.

14 Sec. 38.40.020. COMPOSITION AND TERM OF OFFICE. The commission
15 consists of 10 citizens of Alaska appointed by the governor on a non-
16 partisan basis to give representation on the commission to groups
17 interested in the development of parks and recreational areas in the
18 state. Members of the commission are appointed for three-year terms,
19 except that initial appointments shall be four for three years, three
20 for two years, and three for one year.

21 Sec. 38.40.030. COMPENSATION AND PER DIEM. Members of the com-
22 mission serve without compensation but receive the same transportation
23 costs and per diem as state officials and employees.

24 Sec. 38.40.040. QUALIFICATIONS OF COMMISSION MEMBERS. Members
25 of the commission shall be appointed from persons with knowledge and
26 experience in the areas of conservation, parks and recreation and from
27 the general public.

28 Sec. 38.40.050. MEETINGS. The commission shall meet at least
29 once a year.

1 Sec. 38.40.060. DUTIES. The commission shall advise the depart-
2 ment and make recommendations to it in regard to programs for the
3 development of parks and recreational facilities.
