5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act increasing minimum base salaries for teachers."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 14.20.220(a) is amended to read:

9 (a) The school board of each school district shall pay a regu-
10 larly qualified teacher employed by it a salary not less than that set
11 out in this subsection plus the regional adjustments set out in (b),
12 (c), (f) or (g) of this section.

13 (1) The base salary of a teacher with three years' training
14 is \$8,600 [\$5,400] for a teacher with no public school experience in
15 the state. The salary is augmented by \$200 for each year of public
16 school experience in the state up to and including four years.

17 (2) The base salary for a teacher holding a bachelor's
18 degree and having the requisite number of hours in education is \$9,600
19 [\$6,400]. This salary is augmented by the sum of .04 times the base
20 for each year of public school experience in the state up to and includ-
21 ing eight years.

22 (3) The base salary for a teacher having a master's degree
23 and the required number of hours of education is \$10,100 [\$6,900]. This
24 salary is augmented by the sum of .04 times the base for each year of
25 teaching experience in the state up to and including 12 years.
