6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the pioneers' homes."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 47.25.020(a) is amended to read:

9 (a) Every worthy person residing in the state who is a resident
10 [HAS BEEN A RESIDENT OF THE STATE CONTINUOUSLY FOR MORE THAN 15 YEARS
11 IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING HIS APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION,] and who is
12 destitute and in need of the aid or benefit of the home because of
13 physical disability or other cause, is entitled to admission to the
14 home under the conditions, limitations and penalties prescribed by the
15 regulations of the Department of Administration. No person may be
16 admitted as a guest to the Alaska Pioneers' Home under the provisions
17 of secs. 10 - 110 of this chapter, if the support and maintenance of
18 the person is imposed by law upon a relative or member of the family
19 of the person.
