6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the establishment of recreational  
7 complexes by first and second class boroughs; and  
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 07.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 07.15.332. RECREATIONAL COMPLEXES. (a) A first and second  
12 class borough may provide for a recreational complex to supplement  
13 borough public school recreational facilities. Where feasible,  
14 recreational complexes shall be located in the immediate vicinity of  
15 borough schools.

16 (b) Operation and control of a recreational complex is the  
17 responsibility of a committee appointed by the borough assembly.

18 (c) A recreational complex shall be maintained for continuous  
19 public use and shall be open seven days a week for 12 months of the  
20 year.

21 (d) Construction and maintenance of a recreational complex  
22 is funded on the basis of state matching assistance in the amount  
23 of 75 per cent, when 25 per cent of the cost is paid by the borough.  
24 Any federal assistance available shall reduce the amount of the state  
25 contribution under this section.

26 (e) The Department of Public Works is responsible for the  
27 design, plan, and construction of a recreational complex, and shall  
28 apply to the appropriate federal agency for any federal assistance  
29 available.

1 (f) The Department of Natural Resources, under the provisions of  
2 AS 41.20.020, shall cooperate and assist in the development of a  
3 recreational complex under this section.

4 (g) In this section, a "recreational complex" means a multipurpose,  
5 enclosed, covered community recreation area which contains a variety  
6 of sports facilities, a swimming pool, and sufficient area for public  
7 assembly.

8 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1970.
