6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to emergency industrial impact areas;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.17.075(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) In addition to the amounts authorized to be paid to school
11 districts under this chapter, a supplemental allocation equivalent to
12 \$200 [\$15] per pupil in total average daily membership for the purpose
13 of further equalization of disparities due to size and availability of
14 local resources may be made. These allocations shall be distributed on
15 the basis of average daily membership in the inverse ratio that each
16 district's total equivalent evaluation per pupil bears to the average
17 equivalent evaluation per pupil. However, for a district whose total
18 equivalent evaluation per pupil is below the average, and whose average
19 daily membership is below 600, the allocation may be increased by 20
20 [10] per cent for each unit of 100 by which the district average daily
21 membership, rounded to the nearest 100, is less than 600, provided
22 that the district makes a local contribution of not less than that
23 which would be raised by a 6-mill [10-MILL] levy.

24 * Sec. 2. AS 14.17.075(c) is amended to read:

25 (c) The commissioner shall make adjustments necessary to insure
26 that no district receives less than \$200 [\$15] per pupil in ADM under
27 this section when increased payments to the district from state tuition
28 over the prior year are considered.

29 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1970.
