5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the legislature."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 24.05.080 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 24.05.080. TERMS. The term of each member of the legislature
10 begins on the fourth [SECOND] Monday in January following election. The
11 term of representatives is two years, and the term of senators is four
12 years. One-half of the senators shall be elected every two years.

13 * Sec. 2. AS 24.05.090 is amended to read:

14 Sec. 24.05.090. REGULAR SESSIONS. The legislature shall convene
15 at the capital each year on the fourth [SECOND] Monday in January at
16 10:00 a.m. Pacific Standard Time. Each legislature shall have a dura-
17 tion of two years and shall consist of a "First Regular Session" which
18 shall meet in the odd-numbered years and a "Second Regular Session"
19 which shall meet in the even-numbered years and any special session or
20 sessions which the governor or legislature may find necessary to call.
