6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to special education outside the
7 state for exceptional children."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.30.295(b)(2) is amended to read:

10 (2) the Department of Education shall pay whichever of the
11 following amounts is less, but not to exceed \$5,000 [\$3,000]:

12 (A) 75 per cent of the annual cost of the child's
13 education; or

14 (B) an amount which, when added to the contribution in
15 (b)(1) of this section, equals the total cost of the child's
16 education;

17 * Sec. 2. AS 14.30.295(b)(3) is amended to read:

18 (3) the parent or guardian shall pay the remainder of the
19 cost unless [THE SCHOOL BOARD OR] the commissioner [, IF A STATE-
20 OPERATED SCHOOL,] determines upon the basis of standards set by the
21 commissioner of education in cooperation with the Department of Health
22 and Welfare, that the parent or guardian is unable to pay all or part
23 of the remainder of the cost. The [SCHOOL DISTRICT OR THE] Department
24 of Education [, IF A STATE-OPERATED SCHOOL,] shall pay the remainder
25 of the cost which the parent or guardian is unable to pay.
