6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to an increase in the rate of
7 compensation for temporary total disability,
8 permanent partial disability, and permanent total
9 disability; and providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 23.30.175 is amended to read:

12 Sec. 23.30.175. RATES OF COMPENSATION. (a) Compensation for
13 temporary disability or permanent partial disability may not exceed
14 \$125 [\$113] a week and may not be less than \$25 a week. If the
15 employee's average weekly wages, as computed under sec. 220 of this
16 chapter, are less than \$25 a week, he shall receive as compensation
17 for temporary disability his average weekly wages.

18 (b) In computing compensation for permanent total disability
19 the average weekly wages are considered to have been not more
20 than \$125 [\$113]. If the average weekly wages as computed under
21 sec. 220 of this chapter are less than \$25 a week he shall receive
22 as compensation for permanent total disability his average weekly
23 wages.

24 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1970.
