6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to an increase of employer and/or  
7 carrier contributions to the Alaska second injury  
8 fund; and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 23.30.040(b) is amended to read:

11 (b) If an employee suffers a compensable injury which results  
12 in permanent partial disability, the employer or his insurance  
13 carrier shall, in addition to the compensation provided for, pay  
14 into the second injury fund a lump sum equal to eight [FIVE] per  
15 cent of the total compensation to which the employee is entitled for  
16 the permanent partial disability, as soon as the total amount of the  
17 permanent partial disability payable for the particular injury is  
18 determined by the board. If an employee suffers death under this  
19 chapter and is at the time of his death unmarried, and leaves no  
20 children or dependents, the employer is required to pay to the  
21 second injury fund the sum of \$10,000 [\$5,000] for the sole benefit  
22 of those entitled to participation as provided in this chapter. The  
23 provision of this subsection shall be waived in and during any  
24 calendar year when the unencumbered balance on January 1 in the  
25 second injury fund is equal to or exceeds the sum of \$200,000.
