IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
SIXTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the reporting of workmen's
compensation payments; and providing for an effective
date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 23.30.155(c) is amended to read:

(c) Upon making the first payment[,] or [AND] upon suspension of
payment for [OF] any cause, the employer shall [IMMEDIATELY] notify
the board within 10 days, on [IN ACCORDANCE WITH] a form prescribed by
the board, that payment [OF COMPENSATION] has begun or has been
suspended, as the case may be. If the employer fails to so notify the
board, the board shall assess a civil penalty of \$100.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
