8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23.20.380(6) is amended to read:

10 (6) during the week the claimant leaves her most recent work
11 to change her place of residence in order to remain with her husband or
12 family; [THIS DISQUALIFICATION CONTINUES UNTIL THE CLAIMANT EARNS AD-
13 DITIONAL WAGES, WHETHER OR NOT COVERED BY THIS CHAPTER, OF AT LEAST
14 \$120;]

15 * Sec. 2. AS 23.20.380(7) is amended to read:

16 (7) during the week the claimant leaves her most recent work
17 to be married; [THIS DISQUALIFICATION CONTINUES UNTIL THE CLAIMANT EARNS
18 ADDITIONAL WAGES, WHETHER OR NOT COVERED BY THIS CHAPTER, OF AT LEAST
19 \$120;]

20 * Sec. 3. AS 23.20.380(8) is amended to read:

21 (8) during the week the claimant's unemployment is found to
22 be due to pregnancy; [THIS DISQUALIFICATION CONTINUES UNTIL THE CLAIM-
23 ANT EARNS ADDITIONAL WAGES, WHETHER OR NOT COVERED BY THIS CHAPTER, OF
24 AT LEAST \$120;]
