6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to fishing derbys; and providing
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 16.05.061. FISHING DERBYS. (a) A fishing derby
11 association may, by complying with the license requirements of sec.
12 480 of this chapter, sell or offer to sell sport caught fish obtained
13 as a direct result of a fish derby duly authorized under the terms
14 of AS 05.15.100 - 05.15.180 if

15 (1) the proceeds of such sale are kept in a separate
16 account free from all other moneys, accounts, or funds of the
17 association;

18 (2) the proceeds of such sale are expended only for
19 projects of a civic or charitable nature, for which the commissioner
20 has given prior written approval;

21 (3) the proceeds of such sale are not retained by the
22 organization for a period exceeding one year.

23 (b) A fishing derby association shall make a full and complete
24 annual accounting, upon forms provided by the commissioner, on or
25 before December 31 of the year in which funds from the sale of
26 donated fish of a fish derby are received, retained, or expended.
27 This requirement does not apply to association funds obtained prior
28 to the effective date of this Act.

29 * Sec. 2. AS 16.05.940 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

1 (23) "fish derby" means a contest in which prizes are
2 awarded for catching fish;

3 (24) "fishing derby association" means a civic, service
4 or charitable organization in the state, not for pecuniary profit,
5 whose primary purpose is to promote interest in fishing for recreational
6 purposes and which has been in existence for five years before applying
7 for a permit under this chapter, but does not include an organization
8 formed or operated for gaming or gambling purposes.

9 * Sec. 3. AS 16.05.680 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 16.05.680. UNLAWFUL PURCHASES. It is unlawful for a person,
11 his agent, or his representative (1) to have in his employ a fisherman
12 who is not licensed under sec. 480 of this chapter, or (2) to purchase
13 fish from a fisherman or association [WHO IS] not so licensed, if the
14 fisherman or association is not exempt under secs. 660 - 661 [SEC. 660]
15 of this chapter from the license requirement of sec. 480 with regard
16 to the employment or purchase.

17 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1970.
