6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to eligibility for veteran loans." ✓ ✓

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 26.15.130(a)(1) is amended to read:

9 (1) persons who served in the armed forces of the United
10 States for 90 days or more, or whose service was for less than 90 days
11 because of injury or disability incurred in the line of duty, between
12 April 6, 1917, and November 11, 1918, and September 16, 1940, and
13 July 25, 1947, or in a combat zone during any period of armed conflict,
14 who were separated from the armed forces with a discharge other than
15 dishonorable, and

16 (A) who, at the time of induction into the service,
17 were residents of the territory, who had been residents for not
18 less than one year immediately before their induction, and who
19 returned to the territory or state after discharge as residents
20 with the intention of remaining in the territory or state; or

21 (B) who, not being bona fide residents of the territory
22 before their entry into the service, have lived in the territory
23 or state for at least five [10] years following their release from
24 active military service;
