6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state participation under
7 Title 42 U.S.C., secs. 2991-2994d; and providing
8 for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 44.19 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 44.19.895. PARTICIPATION. Domestic or volunteer service
12 programs authorized by 42 U.S.C., secs. 2991-2994d may not be adminis-
13 tered, formulated or sponsored by the governor nor may he receive
14 or apply for any federal funds available for these programs. This
15 prohibition applies to all agencies of the executive branch, including
16 but not limited to the Office of the Governor, the Alaska planning
17 and research division, and all other departments, agencies, bureaus,
18 divisions or commissions authorized by Title 44 of the Alaska Statutes.
19 The governor may not withhold consent to the assignment of volunteers
20 under programs authorized by 42 U.S.C., secs. 2991-2994d.

21 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approv-
22 al or on the day it becomes law without approval.
