6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the replacement of or
7 compensation for permanent markers by the
8 Department of Highways."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 19.10.260 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

11 Sec. 19.10.260. REPLACEMENT OF OR COMPENSATION FOR PERMANENT
12 MARKERS. The Department shall replace or compensate for replacement
13 of all permanent markers on private or municipal property that were
14 destroyed or lost during highway construction if the markers were in
15 actual evidence before construction. Proof of prior marking of
16 property shall be furnished by the owner prior to construction.
17 Markers may be reset in either the original position or on the newly
18 established right-of-way line except in the case of base control
19 survey monuments which shall be reset in their original position.
