6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to presence of minors on licensed
7 premises; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.15.020(d) is amended to read:

10 (d) Presence of minors on premises. It is unlawful to permit a
11 person under the age of 21 years to enter or remain upon licensed
12 premises unless he [THE MINOR] is accompanied by his parent, guardian
13 or spouse who has attained the age of 21 years. However, a person 18
14 years of age or older may enter and remain upon licensed premises in
15 the course of his employment as a musician, entertainer or busboy. In
16 addition, a person who is 19 or 20 years old may enter and remain upon
17 licensed premises which are also recognized as a restaurant for the
18 purpose of dining or dancing. A person under the age of 19 years
19 may enter and remain upon licensed premises which are also recognized
20 as a restaurant for the purpose of dining or dancing if accompanied by
21 his parent or guardian or by the parent or guardian of any other minor
22 also present, or with any other adult with the consent of the minor's
23 parent or guardian. The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, with the
24 approval of the city council if the premises are within the city or
25 with the approval of the borough assembly if the premises are outside
26 the city but within a borough, shall designate which premises are res-
27 taurants for the purposes of this section. Licensed premises are
28 premises holding licenses under AS 04.10.020(a) - 04.10.020(d). The
29 Alcoholic Beverage Control Board shall promulgate regulations for the

1 designation of restaurants and the continuation or withdrawal of the
2 designation. No establishment may be designated as a restaurant for
3 purposes of dining without the consent of the licensee.

4 * Sec. 2. AS 23.10.355 is amended to read:

5 Sec. 23.10.355. PERSONS [CHILDREN] UNDER 21. No person [MINOR]
6 under 21 may be employed or allowed to sell or serve intoxicating
7 liquors or to work in any room or other place where intoxicating
8 liquors are sold for consumption on the premises, except as provided in
9 AS 04.15.020(d).

10 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
11 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
