6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to liquor licenses."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 04.10.070 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 04.10.070. CLUB LICENSE. (a) A club license given to clubs,  
10 fraternal organizations, and patriotic organizations, that have a state  
11 or national charter, and that have been so incorporated and active for  
12 a period of two years or more, the right to sell intoxicating liquors  
13 to members and their families only in their club rooms. The club  
14 license fee is \$400, except that where any club has certified to the  
15 board that the gross sales of intoxicating liquor for the preceding  
16 year were less than \$5,000 the club license fee is \$200.

17 (b) No license may be issued under (a) of this section or under  
18 sec. 40 of this chapter to a club, fraternal organization, or patriotic  
19 organization which excludes a person from its membership, or denies  
20 services to a guest of a member or otherwise discriminates against a  
21 member or guest of a member, because of race, color or national origin.
