6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to physical therapists and providing
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 03.84.030(4) is amended to read:

10 (4) pass [QUALIFY BY (A) PASSING] to the satisfaction of
11 the board an examination from the professional examination service
12 of the American Public Health Association, [CONDUCTED BY THE BOARD,]
13 to determine his fitness for practice as a physical therapist[;] or
14 be [(B) BEING] entitled to registration without examination as provided
15 in sec. 60 of this chapter;

16 * Sec. 2. AS 08.84.050 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

17 (5) temporary permit \$10

18 * Sec. 3. AS 08.84 is amended by adding a new section to read:

19 Sec. 08.84.065. TEMPORARY PERMIT. (a) The board may issue a
20 nonrenewable temporary permit to an applicant for licensure by
21 reciprocity or by examination who meets the requirements of sec. 30 (1),
22 (2) and (3) of this chapter and pays the required fee.

23 (b) A temporary permit issued to an applicant for licensure by
24 reciprocity is valid for eight months or until the board considers
25 the applicant's reciprocity application, whichever occurs first.

26 (c) A temporary permit issued to an applicant for licensure by
27 examination is valid for eight months or until the results of the
28 first examination for which the applicant is scheduled are published,
29 whichever occurs first. If the applicant fails to take the first

1 examination for which he is scheduled his temporary permit lapses on
2 the day of the examination.

3 * Sec. 4. AS 08.84.080 is amended to read:

4 Sec. 08.84.080. EXAMINATIONS. (a) The board shall examine
5 applicants for registration as physical therapists at the times and
6 places it determines. It may employ two registered physical therapists
7 to aid it in the examination.

8 (b) An application for examination shall be submitted to the
9 department at least 40 days prior to the examination date.

10 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and appro-
11 val or on the day it becomes law without approval.
