6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for exercise by organized boroughs
7 of parks and recreation powers in the borough area
8 outside cities."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 07.15 is amended by adding new sections to read:

11 Sec. 07.15.712. PARKS AND RECREATION POWER. The first class
12 borough may provide for parks, playgrounds and other recreational facilities
13 and services in the area outside cities. The exercise of the
14 power conferred in this section is not subject to the provisions of
15 AS 29.10.126 governing exercise of the power by first class cities.

16 Sec. 07.15.727. PARKS AND RECREATION POWER. The second class
17 borough may provide for parks, playgrounds and other recreational
18 facilities and services in the area outside cities. The exercise of
19 the power conferred in this section is at the option of the borough and
20 is not subject to the restrictions on acquiring additional powers
21 specified in secs. 720 and 730 - 800 of this chapter or the provisions
22 of AS 29.10.126 governing exercise of the power by first class cities.

23 * Sec. 2. AS 07.17.020 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

24 (c) A third class borough may provide for parks, playgrounds and
25 other recreational facilities and services in the area outside cities
26 as provided for second class boroughs in AS 07.15.727.
