HOUSE BILL NO. 631

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SIXTH LEGISLATURE -- SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the settlement of the Alaska
Native land claims; and providing for an effective
date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 38.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 38.15.020. NATIVE LAND CLAIMS SETTLEMENT. A state commis-
sion or other agency which is established in accordance with federal
legislation settling Alaska Native land claims is authorized to permit
disbursement of settlement awards only to Natives, Native corporations
or Native villages, and may not make disbursements to other persons or
organizations except for disbursements for reasonable out-of-pocket
expenses and attorney fees.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
or on the day it becomes law without approval.
