6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to pre-elementary education."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 14.03 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 14.03.065. PRE-ELEMENTARY SCHOOL. A pre-elementary school
10 is a school which provides an educational program for children of pre-
11 elementary age.

12 * Sec. 2. AS 14.03.080 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

13 (f) A child who is three years of age or who will become three
14 years of age before November 2 following the beginning of the school
15 year, may enter a pre-elementary program. A child who qualifies
16 under this section may enter a pre-elementary class at any time during
17 the school year.

18 * Sec. 3. AS 14.07.030(1) is amended to read:

19 (1) establish, maintain, govern and operate state-operated
20 schools and preschool education programs in state-operated schools;

21 * Sec. 4. AS 14.17.050(i) is amended to read:

22 (i) In computing the allotment under this section, two pupils in
23 average daily membership in pre-elementary and kindergarten are counted
24 as one pupil in average daily membership in other elementary school
25 grades.

26 * Sec. 5. AS 14.17.250 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

27 (13) "pre-elementary school" means a school offering programs
28 for children of pre-elementary age.
