HOUSE BILL NO. 694

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
SIXTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the use of highways by service vehicles; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 28.05.030(5) is amended to read:

(5) the parking, standing, or stopping of motor vehicles, and preserving the right of service vehicles such as buses, garbage trucks, tow trucks and ambulances to make brief stops on the roadway, which stops are necessary in the performance of their services;

* Sec. 2. AS 28.35.140 is amended to read:

Sec. 28.35.140. UNLAWFUL OBSTRUCTION OR BLOCKING OF TRAFFIC. No person may purposely obstruct or block traffic on any highway or street by any means. However, this section does not prohibit a service vehicle such as a bus, garbage truck, tow truck or ambulance from making brief stops on a highway or street, which stops are necessary in the performance of its services.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
