IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SIXTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the compensation of certain state board members."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.07.085(c) and (d) are repealed.

* Sec. 2. AS 14.07 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 14.07.087. SALARY, EXPENSES AND PER DIEM. (a) The annual salary for each member of the Board of Education is \$6,000 to be paid in approximately equal monthly installments.

(b) The members are entitled to the expenses, travel and per diem allowances allowed by law.

(c) A member may act and receive compensation from his appointment until his confirmation or rejection by the legislature.

* Sec. 3. AS 16.05.290 is amended to read:

Sec. 16.05.290. COMPENSATION OF BOARD MEMBERS. The annual salary for each member of the board is \$6,000 to be paid in approximately equal monthly installments. Each member of the board is entitled to travel expenses and per diem allowed by law for each day going to and from and for each day in actual attendance at board meetings and other meetings or conferences authorized by the board.
