6 For an Act entitled: "An Act appropriating for capital improvements; and  
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. The sum of \$3,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund  
10 to the Alaska State Housing Authority to fund acquisition, construction,  
11 equipping and the making of other capital improvements authorized under the  
12 Remote Dwelling Program.

13 \* Sec. 2. The sum of \$21,300,000 is appropriated from the general fund  
14 to the Department of Education to fund acquisition, construction, equipping  
15 and the making of other capital improvements according to the following  
16 schedule:

17 (1) State-operated elementary and secondary	
18 public schools	\$ 4,200,000
19 (2) Regional and area boarding schools	11,100,000
20 (3) Districts of less than 350 ADM	3,000,000
21 (4) School districts exclusive of those

24 \* Sec. 3. The sum of \$13,600,000 is appropriated from the general fund  
25 to the Department of Health and Welfare to fund acquisition, construction,  
26 equipping and the making of other capital improvements according to the  
27 following schedule:

28 (1) Mental health facilities, health and child  
29 care centers and to provide state matching funds for the

1 federal Hill-Burton hospital construction program \$ 5,600,000

2 (2) Water supply and sewerage system

5 \* Sec. 4. The sum of \$25,200,000 is appropriated from the general fund  
6 to the Department of Highways to fund acquisition, construction, equipping  
7 and the making of other capital improvements to highways and roads in the  
8 state according to the following schedule:

9 (1) Federal-Aid Highway Program matching

10 funds \$23,200,000

11 (2) "Off-system" roads program 2,000,000

13 \* Sec. 5. The sum of \$2,300,000 is appropriated from the general fund  
14 to the Department of Natural Resources to fund acquisition, construction,  
15 equipping and the making of other capital improvements to state recreational  
16 facilities.

17 \* Sec. 6. The sum of \$57,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund  
18 to the Department of Public Works to fund acquisition, construction, equip-  
19 ping and the making of other capital improvements according to the following  
20 schedule:

21 (1) Airports - trunk and secondary \$ 4,928,000

22 - bush airports 2,072,000

23 \$ 7,000,000

24 (2) Branch of the Alaska Pioneers' Home  
25 in Anchorage 3,000,000

26 (3) Remote area housing for state employees 2,000,000

8 of Alaska joint library building at Anchorage \$ 6,000,000  
9 (2) Safety and health building at College 1,250,000  
10 (3) Biology science building at College 4,000,000  
11 (4) Dormitory - dining building at College 3,500,000  
12 (5) Utilities modernization at College 1,500,000  
13 (6) Farm improvement facilities at Kenai  
14 and College 800,000  
15 (7) Community College System 8,250,000

17 \* Sec. 8. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approv-  
18 al or on the day it becomes law without approval.
