of Fish and Game; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.05.260 is amended to read:

Sec. 16.05.260. ADVISORY COMMITTEES. The board may make rules and
regulations it considers advisable in accordance with the Administrative
Procedure Act (AS 44.62) establishing, at places in the state desig-
nated by the board, advisory committees to be composed of persons well
informed on the fish and game resources of the locality. The board
shall set the number and terms of each of the members of the advisory
committees, shall delegate one member of each committee as chairman,
and shall give him authority to hold public hearings on fish and game
matters. Recommendations from the advisory committees shall be for-
warded to the board for its consideration unless the board determines
that the presence of one or more members of the committee is desirable
in which case the board shall advise the appropriate advisory committee
chairman. The commissioner shall delegate authority to advisory com-
mittees for emergency closures during established seasons. The commis-
sioner may countermand and make null and void any authority delegated
or order issued under this section. The board shall establish the
necessary rules governing such closures. Per diem and travel expenses
shall be allowed members of an advisory committee called to appear before
the board.
