6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the warehousing of intoxicating
7 beverages; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 04.15.035. WAREHOUSING OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR. (a) A

11 licensee may not stock, warehouse, or otherwise store alcoholic liquor
12 in a place other than the premises indicated on his license unless

13 (1) the premises to be used for storage are inspected and
14 approved by the board prior to their use;

15 (2) the use of the premises for storage is authorized by
16 applicable zoning ordinances; and

17 (3) the premises are accessible for inspection as provided
18 in sec. 20(f) of this chapter.

19 (b) No liquor sales or other liquor business may be transacted
20 from premises approved for storage under this section.

21 (c) Intoxicating liquor that is warehoused or otherwise stored
22 on premises that are not licensed or have not been approved under this
23 section is contraband and subject to confiscation by the state and
24 any intoxicating liquor seized shall be sold as provided in sec. 50
25 of this chapter.

26 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
27 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
