6 For an Act entitled: "An Act creating the division of recruitment and re-
7 tention within the Department of Military Affairs."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 26 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 03. DIVISION OF RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION.

11 Sec. 26.03.010. RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION DIVISION. There is
12 created within the Department of Military Affairs a division of recruit-
13 ment and retention.

14 Sec. 26.03.020. APPOINTMENT OF DIRECTOR. The adjutant general
15 shall appoint a director who is at least an administrative officer
16 three.

17 Sec. 26.03.030. AUTHORITY AND DUTIES OF THE DIRECTOR. The
18 director shall

19 (1) take the necessary steps to assure that unemployed
20 guardsmen have the opportunity to acquire employment through the state
21 and federal governments;

22 (2) keep guardsmen advised of all privileges and benefits
23 available to them from the state and federal governments;

24 (3) act as a coordinator with the state and federal govern-
25 ments in an effort to increase the availability of education and
26 training programs for guardsmen;

27 (4) compile a list of guardsmen and their educational and
28 training qualifications and submit it to the federal and state agencies
29 for possible job placement;

1 (5) prepare a program whereby guardsmen are trained in fire-
2 fighting and related skills and coordinate this effort with state and
3 federal programs; and

4 (6) provide counseling service for guardsmen in order to
5 find educational, training, and employment opportunities for them.
