6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the licensing and responsibilities
7 of registered pharmacists; and providing for an
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 08.80.160 is amended by adding the following paragraph
11 to read:

12 (8) license amendment or replacement fee 2

13 * Sec. 2. AS 08.80.270 is amended to read:

14 Sec. 08.80.270. REPORT OF EMPLOYEE. (a) An owner or manager
15 of a pharmacy shall report to the board at the time the board directs,
16 but not more often than once each year, the names of all clerks employed
17 in his pharmacy, and not more than twice each year the names of all
18 pharmacists employed in his pharmacy.

19 (b) An owner or manager of a pharmacy shall forward to the board
20 a change of employee notice within ten days of hiring or dismissing a
21 pharmacist.

22 * Sec. 3. AS 08.80.330 is amended to read:

23 Sec. 08.80.330. LICENSED PHARMACIST AS MANAGER. (a) If the
24 owner of a pharmacy is not a licensed pharmacist, he shall place a
25 licensed pharmacist, designated the manager, in full charge and
26 control of the pharmacy. The manager shall insure compliance with
27 all laws, rules and regulations governing the operation of the
28 pharmacy. The licensed pharmacist shall immediately advise the board
29 of his appointment as manager.

1 (b) No certificate shall be issued to a pharmacy unless there
2 is a licensed registered pharmacist in charge whose name appears on
3 the face of the certificate.

4 * Sec. 4. AS 08.80.350 is amended to read:

5 Sec. 08.80.350. TECHNICAL AIDS REQUIRED. Each licensed pharmacy
6 shall have on the premises a copy of the most recent revision of
7 at least two of the following: the "National Formulary," [A COPY OF
8 THE MOST RECENT REVISION OF] the "United States Pharmacopoeia," the
9 "United States Dispensatory," or the "Remington's Practice of Pharmacy".
10 In addition, each pharmacy shall have [AND] sufficient technical
equipment to properly compound prescriptions and pharmaceutical
preparations. No license may be issued until the requirements of this
13 section are met.

14 * Sec. 5. AS 08.80.380 is amended to read:

15 Sec. 08.80.380. SALES BY STORES AND ROADHOUSES. The board may
16 [SHALL] authorize a store or roadhouse [, LOCATED THREE MILES OR MORE
17 FROM A LICENSED PHARMACY TO HANDLE AND SELL] to sell, in original
18 containers only, nonpoisonous patent medicines, remedies for [HORSES,
19 DOGS AND OTHER] domestic birds and animals, [AND] household remedies
20 and surgical dressings. [THESE MEDICINES, REMEDIES AND SURGICAL
21 DRESSINGS SHALL BE IN THE ORIGINAL PACKAGE AND LABELED PROPERLY AND
22 CLEARLY.]

23 * Sec. 6. AS 08.80.480(2) is amended to read:

24 (2) "medicines," "drug" or "drugs" means drugs or medical
25 supplies which contain poisonous, potent, habit-forming or deleterious
26 ingredients, or medicines containing ingredients which may be
27 considered dangerous or harmful if taken in overdose;

28 * Sec. 7. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
29 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
